This year is already proving to be a busy one! Here at Malborough Baptist we are introducing a whole new programme of events and meetings, but best of all, we are working together with All Saints Parish Church to make them possible.

Starting on the Thursday 18th February, Lent meetings will take place at the Baptist Church with members from All Saints at 7pm until 8pm. This course will last for six weeks, every Thursday, 7pm at the Baptist Chapel, until March 25th. The Lent course is a CD and booklet based study from 'York Courses' and discusses a wide range of questions that all of us ask.

We are also providing a roast dinner every third Thursday of the month at the Baptist Chapel. If you are housebound or find it difficult to get out and you would like to meet some friendly faces, we can also provide transport to pick you up and take you back. The whole idea is to enjoy a good hearty meal and meet others in the village. The dates for this are as follows; April 15th, May 20th, June 17th, July 15th, September 23rd, October 14th, November 25th and December 9th. Only a small donation is suggested to cover costs and there will be a 10 minute sharing and prayer of encouragement.

Have you ever wondered what Malborough was like in the early 1930's – 1940's? We're also planning to have an evening with All Saints at the Baptist Church dressed in period costume, using old lanterns and even cooking a pot of rabbit stew (don't worry, it's not the only thing on the menu)! A video presentation will be made featuring members from both All Saints and the Baptist church sharing their testimonies about their childhood in the 30's. You'd be surprised how different Malborough really was from what it is today! Come along and find out on the 27th March at 6.30pm.

Finally, we are opening our doors on the last Sunday of each month for a celebration of praise and prayer at 6.30pm in the evening (starting on the 31st January). So, if you find it difficult to get to church in the morning, why not come along?
